## Princess/Jr./Little PAGEANT RULES

The purpose of the Morgan County Fall Foliage Festival Queen pageant is to promote our community and to allow local young women the opportunity to participate in a fun scholarship pageant and festival event.

Participants must meet the following recommendations, rules and guidelines:

- 1. Participants must be female and age shall not be less than 5 nor more than 16 years on 1/1/2023. Entrant must attach a copy of her birth certificate as proof of age.
- 2. Participant must currently reside in Morgan County and must present proof of residency.
- 3. Participant must be single, never married, have no children and must not be pregnant at the time of the pageant or during her reign, if crowned queen.
- 4. The use of drugs or alcohol during the pageant or festival by any participant will not be tolerated and will result in immediate dismissal from the pageant.
- 5. All participants must attend an orientation meeting with the pageant director. (Location and date to be determined)
- 6. The queen and her court must participate in various activities related to the Fall Foliage Festival, included being in the Morgan County Fall Foliage Festival parade on Oct. 15, 2023.
- 7. A \$40 non-refundable entry fee is applicable for each participant and must be submitted with the participant's application.
- 8. Miss Fundraiser (OPTIONAL) the top fundraiser will be named as Miss Fundraiser, and be a member of the court.
- 9. The audience will vote on Fan Favorite the day of the competition at \$1.00 per vote.
- 10. All participants must submit a completed application, 4x6 headshot (no bigger), copy of birth certificate, and the non-refundable entry fee of \$40 by the deadline of July 1, 2023.
